

Naturally Aged Flooring

Installer/ Owner Responsibility

Beautiful hardwood Floors are a product of nature and therefore, are not perfect. Hardwood floors are manufactured in accordance with accepted industry standards which permit a defect tolerance not to exceed 5%. The defects may be of a manufacturing or a natural type. The installer/owner has final inspection responsibility as to grade, manufacture and factory finish. He/she must use reasonable selectivity and hold or cut off pieces with glaring defects whatever the cause. Use of stain, wax, filler or putty stick for defect correction during installation should be used as normal procedure. When our flooring is ordered, 5% must be added to actual square foot needed as allowance for cutting waste and mis-manufacture. Should an individual piece be doubtful as to grade, manufacture or factory finish the installer should not use this piece. If he/she does, our liability is limited to replacing defective material in excessive of 5%: material only: i.e., No Labor Costs.
